

MAP AND CATERING FACILITIES

Manchester Metropolitan University



The course will be held in the Lecture Theatre 1 in the Geoffrey Manton Building, Manchester Metropolitan University, Rosamond Street West, Off Oxford Road, Manchester M15 6LL. Please see the notes at the end of the map which give you directions to the course location when you arrive at the venue. Also, see the attached additional information regarding the nearby area.

If no map is supplied, this is because we have been unable to find one we can legally reproduce. Whether one is supplied or not we recommend you have an alternative map. We recommended you print off a Google map which can be accessed by entering the venue postcode into Google maps (www.google.co.uk/maps). It is recommended you print off some travel directions using the postcode you are setting out from as a start point. The AA website (www.theaa.com) also has a good route planner.

The University's Geoffrey Manton Building is located in Manchester City Centre, just off the A57.

By Car:

From the M56 - South of Manchester

Keep in right hand lanes at Junction 3 (signposted City Centre) and continue from the end of the M56 onto A5103 (Princess Parkway), signposted Manchester City Centre. Continue ahead until you reach a major roundabout with an overpass and take the third exit, signposted Sheffield A57(M). At next roundabout take the first exit onto Cambridge Street, and then turn right onto Chester Street and right again onto Oxford Road.

From the M60 - North and East of Manchester

Exit at Junction 22 and turn right at the traffic lights onto the A62. Continue until the end and turn left onto A665 then, following signs for Universities, and turn right. Bear left just before the road rises to become the Mancunian Way and join the dual carriageway, immediately moving into the right hand filter lane to turn right (signposted Manchester Aquatics Centre) onto Grosvenor Street. Follow the signs for Manchester Metropolitan University (MMU) and then onto Oxford Road.

From the M602 - West of Manchester

Proceed to the end of the M602, join the A57(M) (Mancunian Way) and leave by the slip road (signposted Universities) immediately after the MMU buildings visible on both sides of the carriageway. Follow the slip road from the Mancunian Way round to the left and join the dual carriageway (Upper Brook Street). Take the first right onto Cavendish Street and then turn right onto Oxford Road.

If using satellite navigation, input the postcode M15 6BH to be guided to the All Saints campus.

Car Parking

There is no parking available on the campus, but there are 2 multi-storey NCP car parks found on Chester Street and Booth Street East, which are both within a 5 minute walk from the Geoffrey Manton Building. These car parks can be very busy at times, so it is advised that you use public transport where possible.

By Train

The nearest train station is Oxford Road Railway Station which is a 5 minute walk away from the Geoffrey Manton Building. Piccadilly Station & Metrolink and Deansgate Station are also nearby, around a 10 minute walk from the venue. There is a train from Piccadilly Station & Metrolink that stops at Oxford Road Railway Station. A local taxi firm is Village Cars on 01612373383 or alternatively, there is Street Cars, on 01612368033.

By Bus

From Piccadilly Railway Station, take the 147 bus that stops outside the BBC on Oxford Road. You can also get numerous buses heading towards South Manchester, which all stop at the All Saints Campus. These buses are numbers 41, 42, 43, 85, 111, 250 and 256. There's also a free hop-on/hop-off city centre shuttle service that covers the main city centre areas, linking the main city centre railway stations, NCP car parks and many bus and Metrolink tram stops.

The best place to find details of bus services is www.transportdirect.info (you can enter the details of where you are coming from and enter the venue postcode as the destination).

Catering Facilities

Whilst refreshments will be provided, lunch is not included. It is recommended that you either bring a packed lunch, or use the facilities as listed below. The Geoffrey Manton Building and All Saints Campus has a range of nearby catering facilities that are open during term times from Monday to Friday.

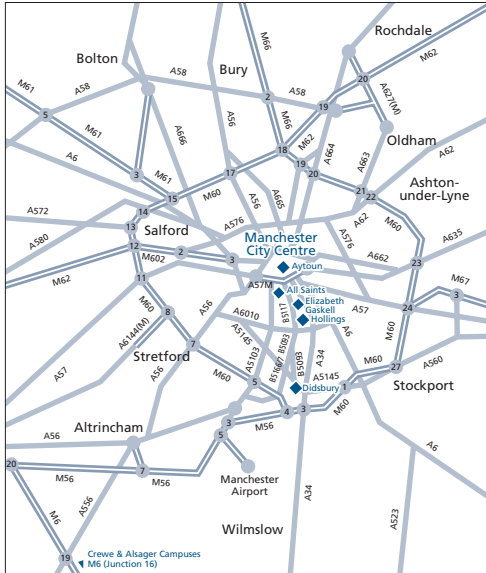
The Geoffrey Manton Bistro (open Monday to Friday, 8-30 to 15-30) is found on the Ground Floor of the building and offers a wide variety of hot and cold food including baguettes, jacket potatoes, pasta, pastries and confectionary goods.

The Mabel Tylecote Green Room (open Monday to Friday 8-00 to 14-00) serves hot food, including a Full English breakfast. There is also a variety of vending machines nearby this facility. The All Saints Coffee Bar (open Monday to Friday, 8-00 to 17-00) serves a variety of cold sandwiches, baguettes, salad boxes, fruit pots and also speciality coffees and teas. There is also a nearby Subway that serves a wide variety hot and cold sandwiches and beverages. Subway is found on the opposite side of the street, just off Oxford Road.

Notes for finding the course location when you have arrived at the venue

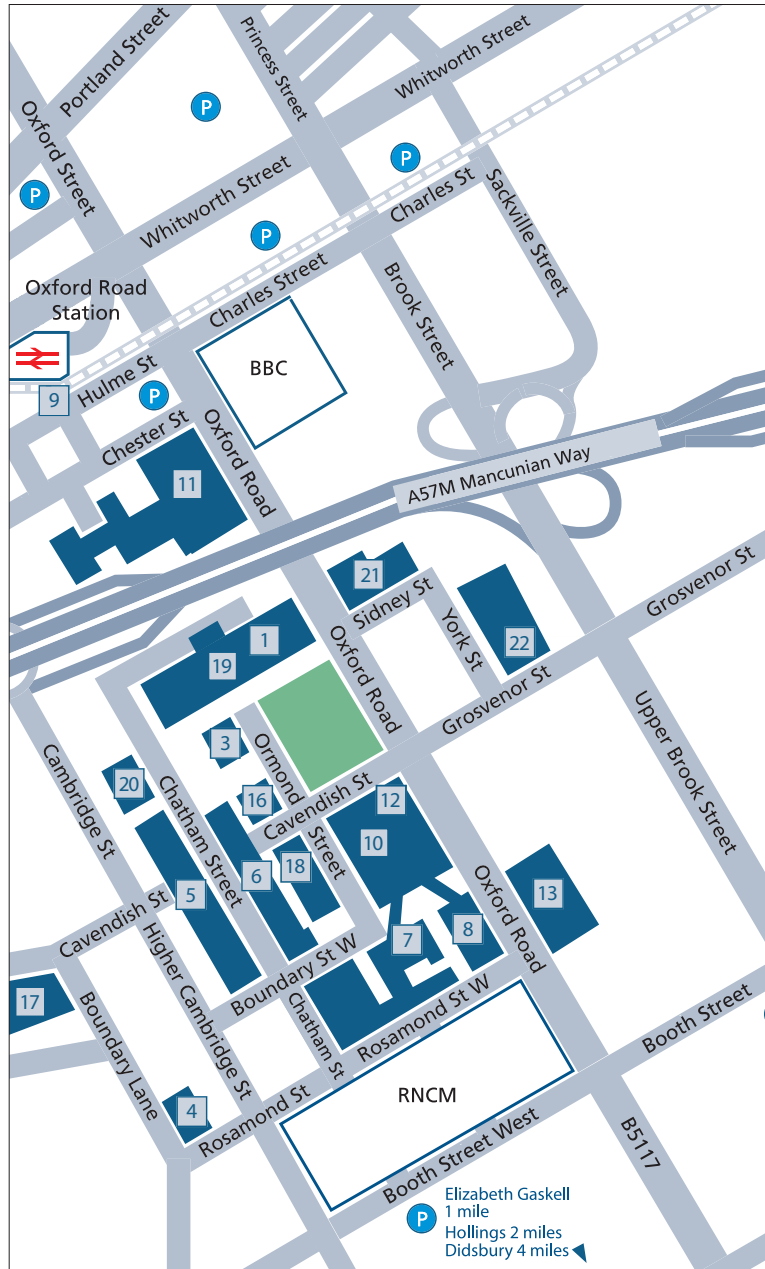
Having arrived at the Geoffrey Manton Building, continue through the front entrance foyer at the Ground Floor. For lecture theatres 1 and 2 (found on the Lower Ground Floor), continue across the atrium into the far corner where stairs to the Lower Ground are found. Lecture theatres 3 to 7 can be found on either side of the room, at Ground Floor level.
