Information and Instructions to Candidates

Common application form to seek admission to University Department of Anna University, Government Aided Engineering Colleges and for the seats surrendered by the Self – Financing Engineering Colleges under the unified Single Window Admission System for Indian Nationals.

1. Application Number Printed in the coding sheet is the Registration Number of the B. Arch. Admission 2012, hence you have to write this number in all the enclosures.

2. ALLOCATION OF SEATS IN COLLEGES

2.1 Seats in B. Arch. Degree Course in University Department of Anna University in the School of Architecture and Planning Campus.

2.2 Seats in B. Arch. Degree Courses in Government Aided Engineering Colleges and seats surrendered by the Self-Financing Engineering Colleges.

(i) Seats in the Self Supporting Course in Govt. Aided Engineering College

(ii) Seats surrendered by the Self Financing Engineering Colleges

2.3 As a prerequisite for selection to B. Arch. Degree course the candidates should have passed the National Aptitude Test in Architecture 2012 conducted by the Council of Architecture, New Delhi.

2.4 A Candidate needs to submit only one application for all the Institutions mentioned above. Candidates seeking admission under special reservation should submit a special reservation form for each special reservation category along with the main application as per instructions given in Para 5.1 on pages 4 & 5.

2.5 Duration of the Programme

5 Academic Years comprising 10 Semesters.

3. ELIGIBILITY

General:

Candidates satisfying the following eligibility rules as on last date of submission of application are eligible to apply. Passing the qualifying examination or changing the religion etc. after this date shall not be considered.

3.1 Nativity

Candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu only will be considered for admission. However, the following categories of candidates are also eligible to apply as Tamil Nadu candidate subject to certain conditions given below:

(A) Candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu

i) Tamil Nadu Native candidates who have studied VIII, IX, X, XI & XII Std. including Diploma in Tamil Nadu, need not enclose the "Nativity Certificate".

ii) Candidates who have passed any of the VIII, IX, X, XI & XII Std. or their equivalent Examination from schools situated outside Tamil Nadu, should enclose a copy of the "Nativity Certificate" (vide certificate No. I) with the application for considering them as candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu.

iii) Applications without proper Nativity Certificate for item 3.1 (A) (ii) will not be considered.

(B) Candidates belonging to Other State (eligible for Open Competition only)

i) Other State candidates who have studied VIII, IX, X, XI & XII Std. in Tamil Nadu, need not enclose the "Nativity Certificate".

ii) Children of Central Government Employees otherwise not domicile of Tamil Nadu may also apply for admission, irrespective of their domicile, provided their parents or guardians (only if both parents are not alive) have been serving in Tamil Nadu continuously for the past FIVE YEARS at the time of submission of application which should be supported by enclosing a certificate from the employer of the parent or guardian, to that effect.

- iii) Sons / daughters of All India Service Tamil Nadu cadre Officers otherwise not native of Tamil Nadu are eligible.
- iv) Children of Employees in Public Sector or Government recognised Institutions who at the time of submission of application for admission employed in Tamil Nadu continuously for the past five years may also apply, irrespective of their domicile, provided a certificate from the employer is enclosed along with the application that the person is a Permanent Employee of the Firm or Institution concerned with evidence like Income Tax return, PF Slip, etc. and is working in Tamil Nadu continuously for the past FIVE YEARS.
- v) Applications without proper Employer Certificate or without Nativity Certificate for the sub clause (ii), (iii) and (iv) mentioned above will not be considered.
- vi) The candidates mentioned in sub clause (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) are eligible for Open Competition only.
- (C) Srilankan Tamil Refugee candidates studying in Tamil Nadu will be considered under open competition as per G.O. (St) No. 172 Higher Education (J2) Dept. dated: 29.06.2010. They have to enclose the following:
 - (i) Identification from Head Quarters Tahsildar
 - (ii) Those who have not registered in the refugee camp, they should submit passport and visa.

3.2 Foreign Nationals are not eligible.

3.3 Qualifying Examinations and Eligibility (i) (a) HSC (Academic)/Equivalent

The candidates who have passed 10+2 or its equivalent examination with Mathematics as one of the subjects.

- (1) OC candidates should have secured not less than 50% marks in aggregate.
- (2) BC/ BCM / MBC & DNC / SC/ SCA / ST candidates should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate.

(b) Diploma

The candidate who have passed 10+3 Diploma (any stream) recognised by Central / State Governments.

- (1) OC candidates should have secured not less than 50% marks in aggregate in all the semesters put together.
- (2) BC/ BCM / MBC & DNC / SC/ SCA / ST candidates should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate in all the semesters put together.

(c) International Baccalaureate Diploma

The candidates who have passed International Baccalaureate Diploma after 10 years of schooling, with Mathematics as compulsory subject.

- (1) OC candidates should have secured not less than 50% marks in aggregate in all the semesters put together.
- (2) BC/ BCM, MBC & DNC, SC/SCA and ST candidates should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate in all the semesters put together.

Note:

1. When the candidates produce Grade certificates, they have to produce actual marks also otherwise only the minimum marks applicable to the grades in the eligible subjects will be taken into account.
2. For the purpose of calculation of marks in respect of sandwich Diploma candidates, the marks of all the other semesters in which there is no industrial training shall be considered for the purpose of calculating the marks for eligibility.

3.4 APTITUDE TEST

The candidates should have passed (pass mark is 80 out of 200) the **National Aptitude Test in Architecture 2012 conducted by the Council of Architecture, New Delhi.**

4. ALLOCATION OF SEATS

4.1. Selection shall be made under seven categories namely Open Competition, Backward Class, Backward Class (Muslim) , MBC & DNC , Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Caste Arunthathiyars and Scheduled Tribe following the rules of reservation of the Government of Tamil Nadu.

The candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu only will be considered for communal reservations and the list of communities eligible to compete against the reserved quota is appended (**Annexure - I**).

4.2. Candidates seeking admission against ST/ SC/ SCA / MBC & DNC / BC / BC (Muslim) quota should obtain the certificates of social status issued by the competent authority in the prescribed **Permanent Community Card in Tamil Nadu** and enclose an attested photocopy of the same along with the application.

(a) The applicants from Tamil Nadu State should have a valid permanent community certificate in the card format issued by the competent authority (for ST/SC/ SCA /MBC & DNC and BC) in the format prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu in G.O. Ms. No. 781 (Revenue Department) dated: 02.05.1988. This is applicable for BCM (BC Muslim) also. In the case of ST candidates, the community certificate should have been issued by the Revenue Divisional Officer / P.A. (General) to the Collector of Chennai / Sub-Collector of the District concerned (except Chennai) vide Govt. Lr. No. 32061/ADWII/89-2, dt: 27.12.1989 and Lr. No. 21424/ADWII/94-4, dt: 15.11.1994 from the Secretary to Government, Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Department, Chennai – 600 009. The Permanent Community Certificate Card issued to ST by Tahsildars up to 11.11.1989 is valid.

(b) Community Certificate obtained from **Other States** will not be considered for communal reservation.

(c) For communities linked with Districts (See Annexure-I) the candidates should obtain their community certificate in the respective districts except the communities mentioned in the G.O. (st) No. 95 BC, MBC & Minorities Welfare Department dt: 28.10.2009. Community certificate obtained from other than the respective district will not be considered.

(d) If a candidate belongs to any one of Code No. 1 to 6 in item No. 9 in the application he/she should furnish an attested photocopy of Permanent Community Card Certificate. **Candidates who have not furnished an attested photocopy of the Permanent Community Card Certificate at the time of submission of the application will be treated as belonging to "General Category" (OC).**

The candidate is informed that in the event of such a decision, the eligibility conditions & rules prescribed for General Category will be applicable for such candidates and if such candidates do not satisfy the rules of 'General Category' (OC), their applications are liable to be rejected. No correspondence in this connection will be entertained.

(e) ST / SC/ SCA / MBC & DNC / BC / BCM (BC Muslim) candidates are eligible for selection under Open Competition in addition to the reservations made for them.

(f) The community recorded in the certificate of Tamil Nadu native candidate should figure in the list of communities approved by the Government of Tamil Nadu (**Annexure – I** on Page No. 22 – 28).

5. Special Reservation

5.1. Special Categories

Since the special reservation categories are being processed by separate committees, candidates are instructed to send separate special reservation form along with main application. They should also enclose a DD for ₹ 100/- for each special reservation along with appropriate certificates. For Differently Abled Persons candidates in addition to the above they have to enclose an additional self addressed envelope for sending the Differently Abled Persons Counselling Call Letter. If appropriate certificates or supporting documents for special reservation claim are not enclosed with the Special reservation form then their claim under such categories will not be considered.

Candidate seeking admissions against the special reservation of seats under Item No. 21, Code No.1 mentioned below for Eminent Sports Person should produce the main application and the special reservation form for sports and a Demand draft for ₹ 100/- and copies of the relevant certificates **in person to the Secretary TNEA as per Annexure II** which also contains the selection procedure. Candidates have to enclose a self addressed envelope for sending the Sports Counselling Call Letter.

Candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu native Only will be eligible for Special reservations.

Note:

(i) Candidates claiming admission against the reservation of seats under item No. 20, Code No.1 should enclose the certificate in the Format given in the information and instructions to candidates (Certificate No. III) from an officer of the Department of Ex-servicemen's Welfare of Tamilnadu not below the rank of Assistant Director of Ex-servicemen's Welfare of the district of which the dependent is a native. Candidates called for counselling should produce ID cards of their parents.

(ii) Candidates seeking admission against the reservation [Item No.20, Code No.2/3/4] set apart for orthopaedically Differently Abled Persons / Hearing impaired (Deaf) / Visually Impaired should produce the certificate from the **Medical Board of the District** concerned certifying the nature and **extent of disability in percentage** and with regard to his/her suitability for admission to Engineering Colleges specifically mentioned below and in the Format

appended to this application (Certificate No. IV / V / VI) respectively. Certificates obtained from the **individual Doctor will not be considered.**

(iii) Candidates seeking admission against the seats under the Special reservations (item 20 & 21) **should also satisfy the eligibility rules mentioned in item 3.** The candidates are also eligible for admission under general category.

5.2. Eligibility criteria for various disabilities

a. Norms for Orthopedic Disability

Candidates with permanent physical impairment of 40% and above are considered as disabled, candidates with orthopedic disability of the following types are eligible for claiming Engineering admission against Differently Abled Persons category (Certificate No. IV on Page No. 19)

- (i) Independent in ambulence with or without calipers but without walking aids.
- (ii) Good Standing Balance without calipers but without any support.
- (iii) Hand Function with normal limit without any aid
- (iv) Good control over bladder & bowl
- (v) Disease must be non progressive

b. Norms for Hearing Disability

Candidates with hearing ability of 40 db and above only in the better ear with speech discrimination score of 50% and above are considered disabled and hence eligible for claiming Engineering admissions against Differently Abled Persons category (Certificate No. V on Page No. 20)

c. Norms for Vision Impairment

Candidates with low vision of 40% and above are considered as disabled, and hence eligible for claiming Engineering admission against Differently Abled Persons category. (Certificate No. VI on Page No. 21)

Low Vision: person with low vision means a person with impairment of vision of less than 6/18 to 6/60 with best correction in the better eye or impairment of field in any one of the following categories:

- a) Reduction of fields less than 50 degrees
 - b) Heminaopia with macular involvement
 - c) Attitudinal defect involving lower fields
- Categories of Visual Disability

6. MODE OF SELECTION

(a) ADMISSION TO GENERAL CATEGORY

The selection of candidates for the above seats will be on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examination and also in the NATA 2012 conducted by Council of Architecture. The candidates should have passed NATA and should submit the mark sheet along with the application. Those who have not appeared and passed in the NATA 2012 are not eligible admission to B.Arch. Degree Course.

HSC Academic/Diploma/Equivalent

The maximum marks for the Aptitude Test will be 200. The total academic marks for H.Sc. candidates will be reduced to a base of 200. For Diploma candidates the maximum marks for Aptitude Test is 200. The academic marks in all the Semesters put together will be reduced to 200. Ranking of the candidates will be based on the total marks of 400 (NATA 200 and Academic mark 200)

A merit list will be prepared based on the total marks of 400. In cases where more than one candidate have got the same marks in the common merit list, the inter-se-merit among such candidates shall be determined in the order of priority as specified below:-

(1) Academic Aggregate for 200 (2) Date of Birth (elder will be given preference) (3) Random number assigned (higher value will be given preference).

The overall rank and Community-wise rank lists will be published in the web site of Anna University, Chennai at <http://www.annauniv.edu/tnea2012>. No separate announcement will be made in the Newspapers. The candidates will also be informed of their rank individually by post through the counselling call letter. The college will be provisionally allotted only through counselling.

(b) Admission to Special Reservation Category

Candidates who are applying for the special reservation categories of seats under item 20 & 21 of (Refer Section 5.1) should satisfy the rules stipulated for admission. Allocation of Special Reservation seats for item 20 & 21 will be followed as per horizontal reservation.

Selection for item 20 will be based on their ranking on the total marks (out of 400) obtained in the qualifying Examination as given in 6(a).

Selection for item 21 will be based on the total marks obtained for Achievements in sports as per Annexure II

If enough candidates are not available under any of the special reservation, the vacancies will be diverted to the general quota.

7. COUNSELLING OF CANDIDATES

7.1 Candidates will be called for counselling in the order of their merit. Based on the merit and communal reservation, allotment to the branch / college chosen by the candidate will be made. Candidates have to opt for colleges and branches that are available at the time of counselling.

7.2 Candidates have to pay an initial deposit by Cash or DD for ₹ 5000/- (₹ 1000/- in case of SC/ SCA /ST belonging to Tamil Nadu) and bring all their original certificates when they attend counselling.

7.3 In the G.O. (st) No. 85 Higher Education (J2) Department dated: 16.04.2010, the Government have ordered to grant tuition fee concession to the candidates who are to be the first graduate in a family, those who are attending counselling and joined in professional courses in Government / Aided and Self-Financing Engineering Colleges. They have to submit the following:

- (i) Certificate obtained from Head Quarters Deputy Tahsildar in the format prescribed in the G.O. which necessarily should include the applicants father, mother, father's father, father's mother, mother's father, mother's mother, brother and sister.
- (ii) The candidates have to furnish a joint declaration by himself and parent/guardian in the prescribed format.

7.4 If a candidate has deposited all the certificates in an institution where he/she has already been admitted, a letter from the Head of the institution should be produced to that effect. In such case only, attested photocopies of certificates from the Head of the institution will be accepted for verification. However, the provisional allotment order will be withheld and it will be released only on production of all the original certificates.

7.5 Eligible candidates who have applied may appear for counselling according to their cut-off mark, two hours before the counselling session along with their original certificates for verification, irrespective of receipt of individual communication.

CHOICE ONCE MADE IS FINAL AND CAN NOT BE CHANGED

The date, time and venue for counselling will be intimated to the candidates, published in leading dailies and in Anna University Chennai Website. No change of date/time of counselling is permissible. Authorities are not responsible for any postal delay; or non receipt of intimation for counselling. Candidates who do not attend the counselling may have to forgo the claim for admission.

Due to unforeseen and unavoidable reasons, if a candidate is unable to attend the counselling on the specified date and time, he/she can authorise his/her parent on his/her behalf and the parent's decision will be binding on the candidate.

If the ranking of candidate is changed due to re-totalling/revaluation of mark, he/she can attend counselling as per the new mark and rank, though the call letter specifies different time (as per original mark).

Once allotted a seat the amount, ₹ 5,000/- (₹ 1000/- in case of SC / SCA / ST candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu) already paid at the time of counselling will be adjusted towards the tuition fee. **If the candidate does not join after allotment and seeks refund, only 80% of the initial deposit amount paid at the time of counselling will be refunded, if original allotment order with acknowledgement for the receipt of payment is surrendered on or before 31.12.2012.** All admissions made through single window system are provisional.

8. REGISTER NUMBER FOR ADMISSION

8.1 Application Number Printed in the coding sheet is the Registration Number for B.Arch. Admission 2012.

8.2 All the enclosures in the application should bear the Registration Number at the top right hand corner.

8.3 The Registration Number should be quoted in all future correspondence.

9. PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION OF APPLICATION FORM

Candidates can obtain the application form **in person** from the Examination centre, Anna University Chennai by paying a registration fee of ₹ 500/- by cash (₹ 250/- in case of SC/ SCA /ST candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu).

Candidates can also obtain the application form by post from the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Engineering Admissions by sending a requisition letter along with a DD (The DD should be drawn in **favour of The Secretary (TNEA), Anna University** Payable at **Chennai**) for the relevant registration fee of ₹ 700/- (₹ 450/- in case of SC / SCA / ST candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu which includes postal charges) and an address slip to which the application is to be sent.

Candidates have to submit the filled-in application either in person or by post along with attested photocopies of Mark Sheet(s), Proof of Age and copies of all other relevant certificates to the **Secretary, TNEA, Anna University, Chennai – 600 025** on or before **29.06.2012**.

Candidates seeking admission under Special Reservation (except Sports Quota) shall submit a separate Special Reservation form along with main application by post or in person in the prescribed format available in "Information and Instructions to Candidates" with an additional fee of ₹ 100/- in the form of Demand Draft for each special reservation enclosing the relevant certificates.

Candidates seeking admissions under Sports Quota are directed to submit their main application as well as special reservation form for sports along with the documents and additional fee of ₹ 100/- in the form of Demand Draft to the Secretary, TNEA, Examination Centre, Anna University only in Person on or before the due date. Such Applications received by post / courier will not be considered.

All Demand Drafts should be drawn in favour of "The Secretary (TNEA), Anna University" payable at Chennai.

The SC/SCA/ST candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu, desirous of availing registration fee concession should submit an attested photocopy of the permanent Community Card Certificate. Other state SC/ST candidates are not eligible for Registration fee concession.

Application forms obtained at concessional rates, if submitted by candidate who does not belong to SC/ SCA /ST will be summarily rejected.

PAYMENT BY ANY OTHER MODE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

10. GENERAL

10.1. The candidates are required to enclose only the attested photocopies of the following certificates along with the application:

10.2. Applications received after the due date, not in the prescribed form, not correctly filled up or the prescribed certificates and documents are not enclosed or do not otherwise fulfil the terms of the instructions will be considered defective and are liable for rejection without notice. The Secretary, TNEA will not be responsible for any delay in Post or otherwise in respect of receipt of application after the due date. No correspondence will be entertained in this respect.

10.3. The candidates are informed that the Hall Ticket of the Aptitude Test should be preserved and produced to the Dean of Anna University Chennai / Principal of the Engineering College, where the candidate is allotted, at the time of admission. Failure to submit the above will result in cancellation of admission.

10.4. All the Columns in both sides of the coding sheets must be filled without fail.

10.5. The candidates have to join the colleges to which they are allotted within the time notified in the Provisional Allotment Order failing which the seats will be deemed to have fallen vacant. No request for reconsideration of admission shall be entertained.

10.6. Detailed information regarding the courses and other facilities are available in the Booklet containing 'Information about colleges'. Other details like Scholarship, Fee Concession, Hostel Facilities, Examinations etc., can be obtained from the Principal /Deans of the Institutions.

10.7. Selected candidates and their parents/ guardians will have to sign a joint declaration in the form given. This declaration should be given to the college at the time of admission.

10.8. Candidates should ensure that correct marks are furnished by him/her in his/her application. If it is found that the marks furnished by him/her in the application are not correct, then he/she will forfeit the admission at any stage of study.

10.9. The candidates are informed that admission given in the counselling are only provisional. In accordance with rules prescribed for admission, if they are found ineligible on actual verification of original certificates / particulars by the principal / Directorate of Technical Education / University, they cannot claim any right for admission or continuation of study at any stage they may be.

10.10 Further, the confirmation of Admission is subject to verification of marks / certificates with the Director of Government Examinations. If the Marks sheet is found to be BOGUS,

- (i) Admission is liable for cancellation at any stage of study,
- (ii) The candidate will be debarred from pursuing any course of study for a period of 3 years
- (iii) Legal action will be taken against him/her for furnishing forged marks.

11. General Instructions to fill up Application Form

11.1. Enter the Registration Number as printed in the coding sheet correctly and legibly in all the enclosures. Failure to do so may result in the application being summarily rejected.

11.2. Encircle the code numbers wherever specified for the entries applicable to you.

11.3. Enclose the relevant certificates wherever asked for along with the application. Submission of certificates at a later date shall not be accepted.

11.4. 4. (a) For International Tournaments:

Category-I : Olympics, World Cup / Commonwealth Games, Asian games (Games organised in 4 years frequency)

Category – II : All other International tournaments not covered under Category I and wherein, not less than six countries had participated and events approved by Indian Olympics Association (IOA) and cleared by Sports Authority of India (SAI), Government of India.

1. Participation / achievement in International tournaments will be considered only with earlier achievements at National / State level tournaments.
2. Only tournaments officially recognised by the Indian Olympic Association / respective official National Federations will be considered for the award of marks (for each year) (1.6.2008 to 31.5.2009, 1.6.2009 to 31.5.2010, 1.6.2010 to 31.5.2011 and 1.6.2011 to 31.5.2012).
3. Participation / Achievements in tournaments, with Form I alone are eligible for marks indicated in Table (I) above.

(b) For National Tournaments

1. The highest achievement in only one annual tournament, officially recognised as the regular annual championship / tournament by Indian Olympic Association / SDAT / SAI / respective official National Federation will be considered (for each year) for the award of marks.
2. Marks will not be awarded for selection trials.

(c) For State Tournaments

1. The highest achievement in only one annual tournament, officially recognised as the regular annual championship / tournament by SDAT / SAI / respective official State Association will be considered (for each year) for the award of marks.

5. General Conditions

1. For consideration of candidates seeking admission under the category of eminent sports person, he / she should enclose attested photocopies of participation certificates and the forms issued by the relevant sports authorities, along with the application.
2. Participation / achievements from 01.06.2008 to 31.05.2012 (1.6.2008 to 31.5.2009, 1.6.2009 to 31.5.2010, 1.6.2010 to 31.5.2011 and 1.6.2011 to 31.5.2012) in sports / games shown in the list alone will be taken into account. National / State Level Championships / Tournaments conducted by organisations recognised by Indian Olympic Association / Sports Development Authority of Tamilnadu (SDAT) / Tamilnadu Olympic Association (TNOA) alone will be considered for award of marks. (Recognition should be relevant to the year concerned).

- A Common Committee for Engineering and Medicine constituted for this purpose will rank the candidates based on the marks assigned to the certificates enclosed along with the application.

10. All the achievement certificates are to be supported necessarily by the relevant participation certificates and appropriate Forms.
11. No further enclosures or certificates under any circumstances will be entertained after the last date for submission of completed application.
12. Required number of candidates will be called to appear for an interview before the Common Committee for Engineering / Medicine for verification of the originals, followed by counselling after ranking.
13. If any candidate fails to produce the requisite Original Certificates / Forms, his / her place will be allotted to the candidate next in rank and so on. The consequential vacancy at the end of the rank list will be filled-up from among the additional candidates according to their ranks.
14. Selected candidates will be counselled and allotment of branches and colleges earmarked for this quota will be based on the ranking before the start of the main Counselling.
15. A candidate can avail seat under sports quota only once for Engineering / Medicine.
