This college has the prime objective of imparting agricultural education and meeting the agricultural research and extension needs of the Union Territory. This college is governed by PAJANCOA (Karaikal) society with the Chief Secretary, Govt. of Puducherry as the Chairman and affiliated to the Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore for meeting its academic standards. This college has been upgraded as Research Institute in 1997.

LOCATION

This college is located in a serene atmosphere at Serumavilangai village of Nedungadu Commune, which is 10 km from Karaikal town and 4 km from the temple town, Thirunallar. The college is spread over an area of 225 acres.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

This institute offers B.Sc.(Agri.) and M.Sc.(Agri.) / M.Sc.(Hort.) Post-graduate programme in six disciplines of Agriculture & Horticulture.

The B.Sc.(Agri.) degree programme was commenced in the year 1987. So far, every year sixty students were being admitted. From this academic year, eighty students are to be admitted. Out of which, 68 seats (85%) are reserved for the candidates of the Union Territory of Puducherry and the remaining 12 seats (15%) to the students of Other States/ UTs (All India basis). In addition 6 seats are allotted for foreign nationals / NRI's. So far, twenty one batches of B.Sc.(Agri.) students have successfully completed. Students of this Institute have shown their academic excellence by securing higher ranks and meritorious positions in the National level competitive examinations to pursue higher degree programme conducted by the nodal Institutions such as ICAR, MANAGE and other SAUs. The alumini of this Institute are well placed in National and International Institutes.

I. ADMISSION DETAILS

i. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

a. HSC/ Equivalent - Academic Stream

A pass in the Higher Secondary Course (10+2) or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to and fulfilling the following requirements.

Eligible subjects of study in the Qualifying Examination

Sl.No.	Degree	Subject requirements
1.	B.Sc.(Agriculture)	Candidates who studied any one of the following groups are eligible to apply: Group-I: Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology Group-II: Physics, Chemistry, Biology with any one of the following subjects as fourth (elective) subject viz., Biochemistry or Biotechnology or Microbiology or Home Science or Computer Science. Group-II (A): Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.

Ranking Procedure

Mark in each of four subjects would be converted to 50 as

$$\frac{\text{Mark Obtained}}{\text{Maximum Mark}} \times 50$$

and the aggregate of the four subjects would be taken for ranking for maximum of 200 marks (50x4=200).

In the case of qualifying examination other than Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary (HSC) Examination, normalization procedure as prescribed by CENTAC, Govt. of Puducherry will be followed. Ranking of the candidates will be done based on the 'normalised marks' (rounded-off to three decimal places) arrived at, to a base of 200.

In cases where more than one student have got the same marks in the common merit list, the inter-se merit among such students shall be determined in the order of priority as specified below:

- i) Marks out of 50 in Biology or Botany and Zoology
- ii) Marks out of 50 in Physics
- iii) Marks out of 50 in Chemistry
- iv) Date of Birth – eldest first

b. HSC - Vocational Stream:

Two seats are exclusively reserved for candidates under Vocational Stream (Agriculture). They are not considered under general merit and any of the reservation categories mentioned under the item I (iii) of admission.

For the H.Sc. Vocational (Agriculture) Candidates, the list of eligible courses for B.Sc.(Agri.) degree programme are given below:

1. Candidates who studied any one of the subjects, namely Biology or Chemistry or Economics or Home Science and Vocational subjects including theory and practical indicated in the table below are eligible to apply for the degree of B.Sc.(Agriculture).

- Agricultural Chemicals/ Crop Production / Crop Protection/ Small Farm Management/ Sericulture & Apiculture/ Vegetables and Fruits / Spices & Plantation Crops/ Floriculture & Medicinal Plants / Home Science.

c. Eligible Minimum Qualifying Marks (Academic Stream / Vocational Stream) as per TNAU, Coimbatore norms.

Note: If the seats shown against any reserved category remain vacant for want of eligible candidates, those seats will be allotted to the candidates under General Category during the last phase of counselling.

b. For Other State / Other UT candidates

Out of the sanctioned intake of 80 seats, 15% of seats *i.e.*, 12 seats will be allotted to candidates from the Other States / UTs . Out of the above seats earmarked for the candidates from Other States / UTs, 15% and 7.5% is reserved for SC and ST candidates, respectively. These candidates should enclose the necessary certificates issued by the competent authority of the respective State / UTs.

Candidates from Other States/ UTs seeking admission have to apply with their +2/HSC marks. Any seat falling vacant under U.T. of Puducherry quota after final counselling will be allotted to Other State/UTs. **Other State vocational candidates are not eligible to apply for B.Sc.(Ag.) of this Institute.**

c. Special Allocation and Eligibility Criteria

(Applicable for Puducherry UT candidates only)

1. **For Vocational Stream candidates:** Out of 68 seats earmarked, **2 seats are exclusively reserved for Vocational Stream (Agriculture) candidates of U.T. of Puducherry only** and they will not be considered under general merit. Vocational stream (Agriculture) candidates should contact the Dean, PAJANCOA&RI, Karaikal directly for admission.

2. **For Village Level Extension Workers:** Out of 68 seats, 2 seats are reserved.

Two seats are exclusively reserved for Village Level Extension Workers who are working in the Department of Agriculture, Govt. of Puducherry.

◆ Village Level Extension Workers seeking for admission to B.Sc.(Agri.) should send their applications duly sponsored and recommended by the Dept. of Agriculture, Puducherry.

◆ They should have passed minimum qualifications of PUC/H.Sc. examination conducted by the Madras University or Board of Higher Secondary Examination of Tamil Nadu or any other equivalent examination thereto with a minimum of marks as mentioned in the I (c) (a mere pass for SC/ST candidates) as aggregate in the subjects - Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Botany and Zoology.

◆ Candidates should not have attained the age of 45 years as on 1st July 2012 of the admission year.

3. **For Wards of Farmers:** Out of 68 seats, 2 seats are reserved.

Candidates who wish to apply for the seats reserved for son / daughter of farmer should satisfy the eligibility as prescribed for H.Sc. / Equivalent

(Academic stream) and produce the following certificates from Officers of the Revenue Department not lower than the rank of the TAHSILDAR (Dy.Tahsildar for Mahe/Yanam region).

- ◆ The parent / guardian of the candidate does not own more than 2.0 hectares of dry land or 1.0 hectare of garden or wetland or their combination;
- ◆ The parent / guardian of the candidate is actually engaged in agricultural farming;
- ◆ The parent / guardian should not have annual income of more than Rs.25,000 from all sources; and
- ◆ The parent / guardian should reside in village / town in the Union Territory of Puducherry.

Note: For maintaining uniformity the extent of land should be given in hectares.

4. **Special Regional allocation:** Eligibility criteria, as per the norms of Govt. of Puducherry.

iii. Other Criteria for admission to B.Sc.(Agri.) degree programme

The criteria stipulated by the Centralized Admission Committee (CENTAC), (web:<http://www.centacprof.net.in>) Govt. of Puducherry for admission to Professional Courses in Puducherry contained in the Information Bulletin 2012-2013 will be followed *viz.*, Nationality, Proof for Residence of U.T. of Puducherry, Other Backward Class, Extreme Backward Class, Most Backward Class, Backward Class Muslim, Backward Tribes, Schedule caste Certificates, Freedom Fighters Category, Physically Handicapped Category, Defence Personnel Category, Sports Personnel Category, Special Regional Allocation for Karaikal, Mahe, Yanam. Separate merit list will be prepared for admission to B.Sc.(Agri.) by PAJANCOA&RI, Karaikal.

The admission is based on the merit category of the candidates, and availability of vacancies at the time of counselling. All admission made by this Institute are provisional and subject to the approval of the affiliated University. The candidates who have offered admission should report to the college on or before the due date mentioned failing which their right of admission is forfeited.

The fees structure will be subjected to change if any modification made by the Govt. of Puducherry. The examination fee, sports fee, Rules and Syllabus book, Academic Calender book and registration fees shall be paid as prescribed by the University.

Note: If a student discontinues the course completely, only the caution money deposit will be refunded.

III. GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION OF FOREIGN & NRI STUDENTS

Over and above the sanctioned strength of 80 seats, 6 seats are allotted under foreign / NRI quota. The minimum qualification for admission under this quota is as follows:

- i. Upper age limit : 25 years
- ii. Minimum marks : A pass in the qualifying examinations (10+2 scheme)
- iii. Fees payable : 1800 USD/Semester or 14000 USD for the entire course (one time payment) along with admission fee of 250 USD per student.
- iv. In the case of NRI quota, the candidates should be sponsored by a Non-Resident Indian who is a close relative of the candidate such as father/ mother/ brother/ sister/ uncle / aunt.
- v. A sponsorer should furnish an undertaking in the form of affidavit regarding all payment.
- vi. The candidates who are seeking admission under Foreign/ NRI quota are exempted from appearing any entrance examinations.
- vii. Regarding students sponsored by foreign countries/ embassies seeking admission into PAJANCOA&RI may submit their application through the respective embassies recommendation/ nomination of their names for admission, subject to production of students visa and fulfillment of minimum eligibility requirements as stated above.

IV. SYSTEM OF EDUCATION

The pattern of instruction and evaluation in the University is the "Semester Course Credit System" in the medium of English. An enrolled student in order to earn a Bachelor's Degree should complete the course credits prescribed from time to time and shall have earned a minimum Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of 6.50 out of 10.00. The duration of B.Sc.(Agri.) degree programme is four academic years, consisting of eight semesters. The NSS/NCC and Physical Education courses are offered as a part of Undergraduate academic curriculum.

Curriculum

- ◆ The curriculum is designed with a view to develop a new generation of agricultural professionals who can lead India to create productive and sustainable food systems and make them globally competent.
- ◆ Major objective of this educational programme is to create qualified agricultural manpower with desired profiles for public and private sectors as well as for self employment.
- ◆ A flexible curriculum enables the students to specialize in areas of their interest.
- ◆ The innovative team-based programme is built around the competencies one needs to succeed as leader.
- ◆ Blended e-learning uses digital technology in supplementing the regular classroom teaching and e-examination.
- ◆ The programme also promotes student's ability to think and learn independently.

Farm graduates are trained in the fields of Information technology, Agribusiness management, Value addition, Quality control, Market intelligence, Rural agricultural work experience, Biotechnology, Organic farming, Natural resource management, Irrigation management, Integrated pest management, Environmental sciences, Post harvest technology, Communication strategies and undergo Internship in Agro Industries to meet the growing needs in these arena.

Field Trips

Frequent field trips employing the twin principles – Learning by doing and seeing is believing are being the unique feature of this institute’s academic programme.

E-learning and On-line System

This institute has introduced e_learning and on line examination systems linked to Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore. Students possess individual laptops and access the on-line learning resources and examinations.

Excellence in Teaching

The high standard of the education is reflected in the good number of candidates who have been selected for scientist positions at national level by Agricultural Scientists Recruitment Board. Many alumini of this institute are doing a commendable service after passing Civil Services exams as IAS, IPS and IFS. In recent years the number of graduates from PAJANCOA joining post graduate courses in U.K and Australia is also on the rise.

i. Note Book computer (LAPTOP)

Laptop is mandatory for the undergraduate students of this degree programme as prescribed by TNAU, Coimbatore. The e-teaching/ e-learning practiced in TNAU necessiated the students to have note book computers for learning as well as writing e-examination.

ii. Working days and time schedule

Except Sundays and other listed public holidays, all other days of a week including Saturdays are working days for the students.

V. FACILITIES

Administrative Building

The beautiful building occupying the front view of the institute harbours Dean's office, Administrative office, Education Section, Library, Computer Centre, Air-conditioned Seminar Hall and Conference Hall.

Computer Facilities

The administrative building has a separate computer centre with 28 computers having Intranet and Internet facility. Apart from this, intranet web server, intranet FTP server and internet server are connected to the computers available in all the Academic buildings. Free Internet access is provided to staff and students round the clock.

Library

The library is well housed with large number of latest National and International text books and journals. More than 7500 text books and 90 number of National and International journals of different disciplines of agriculture and horticulture are available. This library is also equipped with computer and internet facilities.

Academic Buildings

The college has four Academic Blocks housing the various departments of this Institute. Each lecture hall of both Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes is provided with computer, LCD and Over Head Projector as audio-visual aids. All departments are having separate laboratories for both Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes equipped with latest and sophisticated instruments for fulfilling the requirements of teaching and research. Students have round the clock access to Internet and Intranet through laptops using WiFi connections provided in their lecture halls.

FARM COMPLEX

Agronomy

This Department has 85.5 acres of net cultivable area under various field crops supported with modern agricultural machineries. The farm is divided into two units viz., east and west farms. Totally there are four farm ponds harvesting rain water as sources of irrigation. The farm is also provided with two filter points and one deep bore well connected to a well designed inter-grid system, in addition to the canals which bring in Cauvery river water. The farm complex serves as instructional farm for the undergraduate students to teach various crop production techniques and as research farm for conducting field trials of research projects of post graduate students, scientists. The farm includes a Dairy and a Broiler unit for imparting training on animal management and livestock production.

The farm also serves as a model unit to demonstrate various cultivation techniques and farming systems to the farming community and Agricultural Extension functionaries of the U. T. of Puducherry. In addition, Breeder Seed Production is taken up every year to cater the needs of farmers.

Horticulture

This department has an orchard and a botanical garden in an area of 30 acres comprising different fruit, flower, vegetable and plantation crops. An area of 18 acres is separately earmarked for the development of a botanical garden exhibiting different features. A modern green house, fertigation system and shade net facilities serve the academic, research and extension needs related to modern hi-tech horticultural techniques.

HOSTELS

Separate hostels for boys and girls are available with modern amenities such as indoor games, gymnasium, reading rooms, TV halls, water purifying system, water coolers and solar heaters. It is attached with a mess run by the students themselves on a dividing system.

Extra Curricular Activities

The students' club run by student office bearers under the guidance of staff is the platform for exhibiting the extra-curricular activities of the students. Various societies *viz.*, Dramatic, Debating, Hiking, Games and Sports, Arts and Photography etc., are functioning under this club bring out the talents of students from different horizons.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

This institute is conducting location specific and need based research programmes to cater the diverse needs of the farming community of U.T. of Puducherry. This college has currently undertaken several research projects funded by National and International agencies *viz.*, IRRI, ICAR, World Bank, Ministry of Health, Govt. of India and Govt. of Puducherry. In these projects employment opportunities are provided to the Agriculture / Horticulture graduates as Research Associates, Senior and Junior Research Fellows.

EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

Being a major stake holder of agriculture in the U.T. of Puducherry, this college serves as a nodal agency for technology development, refinement and dissemination in the state. This college, in addition to teaching and research, shoulders the responsibility of providing technology support to extension personnel of development departments and farmers by way of organizing training, providing consultancy services, conducting zonal workshops and publishing technical newsletters. Besides directly undertaking field extension activities with the participation of its faculty members and students, it also disseminates agricultural technologies through state and district level seminars, workshops, exhibitions, farmers' melas etc., by joining hands with Department of Agriculture, KVKs, NGOs and other line departments.
