

WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible for WBJEE 2013 the candidates have to satisfy all the conditions in WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria. This criterion will have various clauses which are to be satisfied in order to sit for the exam. If credentials of any candidate at any time of Admission Process are found to be wrong or manipulated the candidature of the subject will be cancelled.

The WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria includes the following clauses:

Nationality:

The candidate should be a citizen of India according to WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria.

Age:

The candidate should be of 17 yrs or above by the end of December 2012 in order to be eligible as per WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria.

However, there is no upper limit on age for taking WBJEE 2013 except Marine Engineering Course for which the upper limit is 25 yrs as per WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria.

Residential Requirements:

The candidates should have been residing in the state of West Bengal for past ten years continuously or their parents should have a permanent residence in West Bengal in order to be eligible as per WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria.

The duration of living will be calculated till the end of December 2012.

Academic Requirements as per WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria:

All the candidates except Marine Engineering must have a minimum aggregate of 45% (GEN) or 40% (ST/SC) in Mathematics, Chemistry and Physics with a minimum of 30% marks in English and must have individually passed all the subjects in order to be eligible as per WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria.

The candidates who are appearing for Marine Engineering in WBJEE 2013 must have a minimum aggregate of 60% in subjects of Mathematics, Chemistry and Physics with a minimum of 50% in English at the level of 10th and 12th class and should have passed all the subjects individually in order to be eligible as per WBJEE 2013 Eligibility Criteria.
