Eleventh and 12th Grade Students

- 3.30 cumulative GPA
- 24 ACT composite or 1110 SAT total (math and critical reading combined score)

or

• 3.50 cumulative GPA with any test scores

NOTE: All applicants must submit test scores for placement purposes, regardless of GPA.

Ninth and 10th Grade Students

- 3.75 cumulative GPA
- 26 ACT composite or 1150 SAT total (math and critical reading combined score)
- Grade of B+ in all English courses

- Admission Application

- Official high school transcripts
- ACT or SAT scores
- Page 4 (Option Selection and Required Signatures)

Additionally, 9th and 10th grade students must submit:

- Letter of recommendation from school instructor or guidance counselor
- Essay about why you want to enroll in the PSEOP
