# **ACCOMPLISHING A MISSION**

The School of Open Learning, University of Delhi, formerly known as the Directorate of Correspondence Courses, established under the University of Delhi in 1962, is a pioneer Institution in the field of Distance Education in India.

The country witnessed the beginning of an alternate mode of education when the School started with a modest admission of 900 students in 1962. The School enrolled more than three lakh fifty thousand students in the Academic Session 2011-2012. On many occasions our students have been toppers in a range of disciplines.

The admission process for various courses in the School is governed by the norms established by the University of Delhi. The examination is also conducted by the University of Delhi. The University of Delhi confers the degree to the students of the School as it does in the case of its other constituent Colleges. There is no differentiation in the course curriculum followed by the School of Open Learning and other constituent Colleges and Departments of the University of Delhi. In an effort to cater to the needs of a growing number of students the School established the South Study Centre at Moti Bagh from the academic session 1990-91. In an effort to reach out to a larger number of students, the School is in the process of opening up Study Centres in the Eastern and the Western parts of the National Capital Region of Delhi.

The School offers Undergraduate / Postgraduate Degree courses in the subjects of Arts / Humanities and Commerce. The mode of instruction is primarily through well prepared printed course material which is distributed at the time of admission or by mail to all the enrolled students. This is also supplemented through Personal Contact Programme conducted for the benefit of students at various study centres run by the School. An experienced faculty is always available at the main campus for academic interaction with students.

The School offers learning through the distance education mode which is a viable alternative for students who need a flexible medium of instruction to attain higher education and vocational skills.

This Prospectus contains essential information for all those who wish to seek admission to various postgraduate courses offered by the School of Open Learning, University of Delhi.

Details about various postgraduate courses offered, minimum eligibility conditions for admission to these courses and the admission procedure are outlined in the subsequent sections hereinafter. Effort has been made to summarize all important information for the candidates seeking admission to the postgraduate courses being offered, however, clarifications for any specific case for which guidelines are not provided herein may be obtained from the School.

The Registration form as well as Enrolment–Cum–Admission form is also included in this Prospectus.

# 2.1 Key Dates for Admission - Post graduate Courses

The above centers observe a Lunch Break from 1.00 p.m. to 1.30 p.m.

The Admission forms will be processed and finalized only at the School of Open Learning, North Campus. Students will have to come to SOL, North Campus for all matters related to their ad missions.

### 2.1.1 Identity Cards

Every student is required to have an Identity Card of the School. The SOL would send the I Cards By Post to the students latest by 30th Sep, 2012. Students are advised to contact the relevant Admission Sections at the Main Campus, if he/she does not collect his/her Identity Card on the above mentioned dates. If this card is lost by the student a duplicate can be issued on payment of Rs. 30/only.

# 2.2 Span Period of Study

All Postgraduate Courses offered by the School have a specified minimum and maximum allowed span period for completing the same. The minimum period allowed is two years and the maximum period allowed is four years for completion of any Postgraduate course. These stipulations are to be strictly observed during the course of study at the School.

#### 2.3 Office Hours

The School remains open for interaction with students on all working days from 9.00 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. Office of the School remains closed on Saturdays, Sundays and other declared Holidays.

# 2.4 Essential Documents to be Submitted (Check List)

Please ensure that the following documents are to be submitted along with the Application for Registration/Admission form. In case the relevant documents are not enclosed, your Application for Registration/Admission will not be considered.

#### 1. At the time of Registration for Entrance Test

- (i) Duly filled Registration From.
- (ii) Draft/Cash (Rs.250/- for Gen/OBC and Rs.100/for SC/ST/PC).
- (iii) Two Passport size photographs.
- (iv) Self-attestted Photocopy of 10th Certificate.
- (v) Self-attestted Photocopy of 12th Passing Certificate.
- (vi) Self-attestted Photocopy of I, II and III Year Marksheet.
- (vii) In case the result of Illrd year is awaited the student will submit the Self-attestted Marksheets of I and II Year and admit card of 3rd year (only for the students of Univeristy of Delhi).

#### 2. At the Time of Admission

In all cases the required fees should be deposited with the Admission Form through Bank Draft on State Bank of India. A Crossed Pay Order / Bank Draft payable at Delhi drawn on State Bank of India in favour of The Executive Director, School of Open Learning, University of Delhi, Payable at State Bank of India, Service Branch, New Delhi. For students residing outside Delhi the bank draft can be obtained from any nationalized bank.

(i) Duly filled Admission Form.

- (ii) Bank Draft for Category 'A' Rs. 5800/-, Category 'B' Rs. 5300/- and Category 'C' Rs. 14,300/- (See page no. 28).
- (lii) Two recent passport size photographs to be affixed (a) one on the Application Form and (b) another on the Identity Card Form. It should be pasted not stapled.
- (iv) Self-attestted Photocopy of 10th Certificate.
- (v) Self-attestted Photocopy of 12th Passing Certificate.
- (vi) Self-attestted Photocopy of I, II and III Year Marksheet.
- (vii) In case the result of IIIrd year is awaited the student will submit the Self-attestted Marksheets of I and II Year and admit card of 3rd year (only for the students of Univeristy of Delhi).
- (viii)Original Provisional Certificate of Graduation for current year student. However, other student is to submit the photocopy of Degree Certificate.
- (ix) Migration certificate in original of the respective University if the candidate is studied from other than Delhi University.
- (x) Self attested photocopy of Reserve Category Certificates of the candidate, if applicable (for example SC/ST/OBC/ PC etc.)
- (xi) Latest Original Income Certificate, if applying for fee concession.
- (xii) Self attested photocopy of BPL Ration Card as well as Original Income Certificate if applying for Financial Assistance
- (xiii)Disability certificate, in case of physically challenged candidates (in duplicate) issued by the competent hospital/board.
- (xiv)Candidates are required to produce all the Original Certificates for verification at the time of admission.
- (xv) The Enrolment number allocated by the college/university is essential to fill in the admission form.

#### 2.5 Additional Information

- 1. Students already on rolls need not apply for admission afresh for M.A./M.Com. (Final).
- Any transaction made otherwise will be at the risk and responsibility of the student.
- 3. Students are advised to keep all the Fee Receipts with them intact till they receive their Degree Certificate.
- A student enrolled with the School, like any other regular student of the University of Delhi, studies the same syllabi and curricula and is awarded the same degree by the University.



- 5. Candidates are not permitted to pursue studies for two courses simultaneously either in Delhi and /or some other University. Candidates are also not allowed to pursue the same course in two different Universities.
- 6. There is no restriction on admission in any course for gap year students.
- 7. It is the basic responsibility of the student to submit the required certificates and documents in support of his/her eligibility, as and when demanded. All admissions are provisional till the verification of original certificates and confirmation by the University of Delhi. The School reserves the right to cancel the admission and / or result of any part of the examination of the concerned Degree Course of any student who fails to submit the required documents within the stipulated time.
- 8. The students are advised to use the Registration Form for Entrance and keep all other forms intact. These forms will be required for completing admission formalities after qualifying for admission on the specified basis of selection for individual courses. The merit list shall be displayed on SOL website https://sol.du.ac.in as well as concerned admission section.
- 9. The students of University of Delhi who have appeared in final year examination in Annual-2012 of any Under Graduate Course can get themselves registered to appear at the Enterance Test of the respective Course in Post Graduate, but their eligibility of admission will only be determined as per University rules.
- 10. The Original Provisional Certificate or Original Migration Certificate submitted by candidate at the time of Admission will not be returned back in any circumstances.
- 11. No person who has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude shall be admitted to a course of study or permitted to take any examination of the University until a period of two years has elapsed from the date of expiry of the sentence imposed on him/her. However, the Academic Council may, in a special case, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
- 12. Aggregate marks in respect of examinations where the results shown in grades and standards attained in different subjects (such as the Pre-University /Pre-Degree Examination etc.) the minimum percentage of the marks for subjects given in standards is taken into account.
- 13. Candidates must ensure their eligibility to the course to which they apply. The School reserves the right to cancel any admission at any stage if found ineligible as per rules and regulations prescribed by the University from time to time. For any legal proceedings, the jurisdiction shall be the Delhi Courts.
- 14. The OBC status is to be determined on the basis of the central list of OBCs, notified by the Ministry of Social

- Justice & Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward classes available at the website of the commission. (http://ncbc.nic.in/ backwardclasses/ index.html) The documents in evidence of the OBC status will be required from the students at the time of registration as well as granting admission.
- 15. Rounding off a fraction of marks for purposes of admission to any course is not permitted.
- 16. Candidates are required to fill in carefully the undermentioned forms after reading all the instructions.
  - Registration Form for Entrance Test
  - b. Admission Form

If any fake attestation/falsified records are detected, the student will be debarred from attending any course in the University or its college(s) for next five years and in addition, a criminal case under relevant section of IPC (viz. 470,471,474 IPC etc.) will be instituted against him, to subject him to the requisite criminal proceeding.

- 17. Students making financial transactions i.e. Fee at other than the counters provided by the School, will be at their own risk and responsibility.
- 18. The candidates other othan Delhi University will not be considered for Entrance Test, if their Final Year result is awaited.
- 19. Candidates who have passed their B.A.(Pass)/B.A.(Prg.)/B.A.(Hons.)/B.A.(Hons) Prg./B.Com.(P)/B.Com or equivalent examination under 10+2+3 scheme of examination of Delhi University or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto, if eligible would be registered to P.G. Courses for the Academic Session-2012-13.

# REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

The minimum requirements for admission to various Postgraduate courses offered by the School are summarized below. Various aspects such as qualifying examinations, minimum marks required, age requirements and course specific requirements are covered hereinafter.

### 4.1 Qualifying Examinations

Qualifying examinations and the minimum eligibility conditions for the purpose of admission to various Postgraduate courses offered by the School are summarized in Section 4.3 below. Each sub-section deals with course specific eligibility conditions.

# 4.2 Who can Apply

- Admission is open to candidates from all over India.
- Admission is also open to Indian nationals working in Indian missions abroad and also to their dependents, subject to appear University Examination at Delhi centre only.
- Admission is also open to Indian nationals settled

abroad provided they are:

- Eligible
- They take the University examination at the Delhi Centre only.
- · They submit a duly attested photocopy of the passport.

On seeking admission to the School of Open Learning, Indian nationals settled abroad shall be required to make an extra payment of Rs.1,500 per year towards postage charges. (All payments from such students will be accepted through Bank

Foreign nationals residing in India are also eligible for admission in this School. Their cases will be dealt with as per procedure laid down under Special Provisions mentioned in section (4.5.6).
