

## **Sr. Secondary**

**Question: What stands for “R.L.E.” in the Board Examination Result?**

**Answer:** The term “R.L.E.” in the result column of the candidate means “Result late due to eligibility.”.

**Q2.. What stands for the term “R.L.A.” in the declaration of Board examination result?**

Ans. R.L.A. in the result column of a candidate means “Result late due to award.”

**Q3.What is the eligibility criteria,procedure and time period for taking the additional subject examination of Sr.Sec.Exam?**

Ans.Candidates who have qualified the Sr.Secondary Examination of the Board(including Open School stream), may appear in additional subject/s not already offered/qualified by them. A candidate who has qualified Senior Secondary examination of this Board or from other Boards/institutions duly recognized by this Board, shall be eligible to appear in additional subject/s of any stream which he/she has not already been irrespective of the stream, in which he/she has qualified the Sr.Sec.Examination provided that while appearing in the exam. as candidate of additional subject, such candidate has to choose subject/s of only one particular stream at a time. In additional subject/s CCE marks will be added proportionately to the marks obtained in the external examination. Candidates appearing for additional subject/s will have to appear for both the semesters’ examination simultaneously. And if a candidate qualifies in any one semester of the additional subject but is unable to qualify the other semester, he/she will be declared “ Re-appear” in both the semesters. There is no time period restriction for taking the additional subject Exam.

**Q4. What is the criteria for awarding grace marks in the Board examination result?**

Ans.In both semesters separately, 1% of the total designated marks for the subjects a candidate has appeared in the examination will be given for qualifying (i.e. for getting 33% marks) in as many subjects as possible, and not for improving grade in each semester separately.

**Q5. What is the pass formula for getting successful in the Sr.Sec.examination?**

Ans. In order to earn the Certificate of Qualification, a candidate will have to qualify in all five subjects of external examination separately in each semester.

In order to qualify in a subject, a candidate will have to obtain at least 33% marks in the aggregate of external examination, CCE& Practicals provided that he/she obtains at least 33% marks separately in the external examination; obtains at least 33% marks separately in Practical paper, if any and there will no minimum pass marks for CCE.
