AFERNANDEZ GARZAbf645a: About the TOEFL, can be waived if I graduated from a High School in Wisconsin?

VGoyal7bc80e: Thanks Michael, Brandi and Evan

bguest(Admissions Ben): @rknowles We don't have a specific score requirement for the quantitative portion of the GMAT. If an applicant struggles on the quantitative portion of the test, the admissions committee will also look at any quant courses taken in UG or masters program to help compensate.

ricemoderator(MBA Student Patra): @PKumar - I don't think the students on this chat interned for NASA so it is hard to say what was offered specifically by NASA.
