- 1. The candidate should appear in the examination strictly in accordance with the date sheet.
- 2. Roll No. should be written on the right of the title page of the answer book only and not at any other place. Answer book number should also not be mentioned inside the answer book.

- 10. Un-authorized change of center is strictly prohibited. If anyone changes his/ her center of examination at his/ her own, un-fair means case will be registered against him/her, similarly no change of subject is allowed unless permitted by the University.
- 11. No one can appear in the Examination without getting his/her Roll Number Slip. Unfair-means case shall be registered against those who will violate the instructions and rules/regulations of the University.
- 12. The candidates are not allowed to bring/use minicomputer/calculator and mobile telephone sets in the Examination Hall. <u>Duration of the English Paper A will be 3 ½ hours, Islamic Studies / Ethics Compulsory 2 hours and Pakistan Studies Compulsory 1 ½ hours.</u> Unfair Means Case shall be registered against those who violate the above or such other instructions as are issued.
