FINANCE YOUR DEGREE

Graduate Assistantships and Fellowships

More than 50% of Full-time MBA students received funding from the College including graduate assistantships and fellowships.

All applicants, resident and non-resident, who apply by the Funding I (November 1) or Funding II (January 15) deadlines are eligible for consideration.

Graduate Assistantships

Graduate assistants work with a Scheller College faculty member or administrator in exchange for a monthly salary and tuition reduction. Estimated value of an assistantship may be as high as \$87,000 depending on the type of award and residency status. Awards are based on academic merit.

Education Loans

MBA students who are U.S. citizens and permanent residents may be eligible for education loans. A variety of privately funded loan programs may be available for international students.

The Post-9/11 GI Bill

Qualified U.S. veterans may be eligible to receive financial support for resident tuition and mandatory fees, and a stipend for books and housing.
