#### **REAPPLICATION**

If you applied for fall 2012 admission, we can use previous transcripts, recommendations and other supporting documents. However, you must submit new application forms, an updated résumé, new essays, one new recommendation, transcripts for any new academic work and the application fee.

#### **INTERVIEWS**

Interviews are available by invitation only. The Admissions Committee will contact you by e-mail to schedule at a mutually convenient time.

#### **CONCURRENT (JOINT) DEGREES**

To apply for a concurrent degree, you must apply for admission directly to each program at UC Davis. Each program will make an independent decision using its own admissions criteria.

#### **RESIDENT STATUS FOR TUITION PURPOSES**

If you are not currently a California resident, you may apply to establish residence if: 1) you are a U.S. citizen; 2) you are a permanent resident or other immigrant; or 3) you are a nonimmigrant who is not precluded from establishing a domicile in the U.S. To establish residence you must be physically present in California for more than one year and must have come here with the intent to make California your home and not solely to attend school. Intent includes, but is not limited to, having a California driver's license or ID card, registering to vote and voting, using a California address on all records, and paying state income tax as a resident. These steps must be taken one full year before the start of the quarter in which you wish to be classified a resident. The Deputy is the only person authorized to give advice, information and final determination on residence matters.
