Candidate should keep scanned copy of latest passport size photo (in jpeg/jpg/gif format less than 50kB) ready before filing online application form.</p> <p>4. Fill in the online form with all the relevant details. Upload scanned copy of your latest passport size photograph in the online application form.</p> <p>5. Click Submit. You will get a system generated 12 digit Application No. Please note that this application no. will be used for all the purpose required for future references throughout the selection process. Take printout of the Online Application Form, after recent passport size photograph, sign in the space provided for signature and keep safe for future reference.</p> <p>6. Candidates are NOT required to submit hard copy of application form to HPCL. The details filled in the online application form will be considered final and no changes will be entertained w.r.t. personal any other details.</p> <p>7. <b>PAYMENT OF APPLICATION FEE:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Applicants are required to pay a Non-Refundable Amount of Rs.600/- (fee inclusive of service tax @ 15 % and bank charges of Rs.25). Applicants can make the payment of fee thru' challan or online thru' debit/credit card by choosing appropriate mode at the time of filing online application.</li> <li>b. SC, ST &amp; PWD candidates are exempted from payment of application fee.</li> </ul> <p><b>Mode of Payment:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Payment through challan at State Bank of India (SBI).</li> </ul> <p>Under this option candidates are required to take a print of 'two part challan' (1.Candidate copy, 2.Bank copy) along with filled application form. Non-Refundable Amount of ₹ 600/- (fee inclusive of service tax @ 15 % and bank charges for SBI) is to be paid for Category-SC/BC-NC candidates. It is to be deposited through authorized challan which is available under candidate's login, in HPCL Portal with A/C Number 32315049001 at any branch of SBI across the country after two working days from date of online application.</p> <p>Candidates are required to ensure that bank affixes "payment received" stamp and Journal no. on two parts of challan. Candidates are required to retain one copy of "Candidate's copy" of two parts of challan and send the same for future reference.</p> <p>Once the payment is received by HPCL against the application no., payment status will change to "Payment Received". Please ensure that your payment status is changed to "payment received" within 3-4 working days from the date of payment of application fee as the application with other payment status will not be accepted. Online Payment through Debit/Credit card:</li> </ul> <p>Under this option candidate can pay applicable application fee online by using Debit/Credit card. The payment status will automatically change to "Payment Received", immediately on successful receipt of fees. In case the payment status does not change immediately, kindly contact the concerned bank or SBI directly or file a complaint or pay through challan at SBI. All the candidates must ensure that the payment status is "Payment Received". The transaction will be considered "Incomplete" in case of any other payment status due to any reason. The candidates must have an active e-mail id and mobile number which must remain valid for at least next one year. All future communication with the candidates will take place through registered email id only.</li> <li>3. The candidates should have the relevant documents like percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination, caste/obscaste certificate, date of issue, name of issuing authority, state/central government or any other competent authority.</li> <li>4. The OBC candidates who belong to "Creamy Layer" are not entitled for concession admissible to OBC/NC candidates and such candidates will have to indicate their category as Unreserved (UR).</li> <li>5. Local candidates are encouraged to utilize the recruitment opportunity since the vacancies are based in Mumbai.</li> <li>6. Candidates currently employed in Government Department/PSUs/Autonomous Bodies will be required to submit NOC from competent authority of their current employer at the time of Skill Test. In case of failure to produce the NOC from the current employer at the time of Skill Test, the candidate will not be permitted to appear for the Skill Test.</li> <li>7. Candidates need to apply for only one post as the written test for all the positions will be conducted on the same date and at the same time in all the test centers.</li> <li>8. Selected candidates may also be posted in any of the subsidiaries/Joint Ventures or any department of Government of India.</li> <li>16. Reimbursement of 2nd class rail fare by the shortest route to examination center for outstation SC/ST/BC/NC candidates appearing for written test/Skill Test shall be made, provided the distance travelled is not more than 100 km in either way. All candidates are required to appear for the written test/skill test with permanent disability of 40% and above. PWD candidates are required to submit a certificate issued by respective competent authorities failing which their candidature will not be considered.</li> <li>21. All the candidates are requested to remain updated on Helpline / SMS services for the Written Test and Skill Test date and Venue etc., by visiting HPCL website.</li> <li>22. Candidates can view their status of payment of application fee by logging in HPCL website with application no. &amp; e-mail ID (as mentioned in online application).</li> <li>23. HPCL reserves the right to raise minimum stringency standards and to reconsider/reassess the merit of vacancies. Wherever CGPA/GPR or letter grade in a qualifying degree is awarded, equivalent percentage of marks should be indicated in the application form as per norms adopted by University / Institute.
