We have audited the Placement Report prepared by you on the final placement (based on offers received and accepted on campus) of students in 2017 of the Post Graduate Programme in Management for Executives (PGPX) of the Indian Institute of Management Ahmedabad (IIM-A). The Placement Report is the responsibility of IIM-A. Our responsibility is to validate the information provided in the report with the relevant documentation and comment on the Placement Report's conformance with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards (IPRS) Revision 2.1.

In this context, we confirm the following:

- For the purpose of the audit, we have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the
  best of our knowledge and belief were necessary. In our opinion, the Placement Report complies
  with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards Revision 2.1.
- The validation of information presented in the report is based on communication received by IIM-A from recruiting companies. Brickwork Ratings (BWR) has not independently sourced any information or documentation.
- We have verified the information with respect to job location, function and remuneration presented in the report with communication received from recruiters.
  - a. The information has been categorised as best as possible under different salary heads as given in the IPRS Revision 2.1; where a break-up was not available, the salary has been considered only as 'Maximum Earning Potential'.
  - b. Stock Options have been mentioned for five students. Our observations in this regard are :
    - For four students, stock options have been mentioned with details on how much vests in the first year. Hence, the corresponding fixed amount has been considered for calculation of 'Maximum Earning Potential'.
    - ii. For one student, stock options have been mentioned without details on how much vests in the first year. As the recruiter is an unlisted entity, the amount relating to stock options has not been considered for calculation of 'Maximum Earning Potential'.
- The acceptance of offers and number of students opting out of the placement process has been established through written communication from those students.
- We have only audited the salary figures in the placement report and not the report's overview section, which explains the placement process.

#### Overview

The placement process for the graduating batch of the One Year Post-Graduate Diploma in Management for Executives (PGPX) at IIM Ahmedabad was successfully completed in June 2017. PGPX follows rolling placement process that started on November 14, 2016 and continued until 3 months after the convocation. Students of PGPX come from diverse backgrounds with a considerable experience ranging from 6 years to 15 years. For a diversified and accomplished student group such as this, recruiters visit campus over the recruitment period to select candidates for their middle to senior level management positions. In this year's placement process, continuing the tradition, students were offered positions such as COO, Operations Director, Associate Vice President, Business Development Executive, Leadership Programs, Principal Consultant, Associate General Manager, Senior Manager, Project Manager and Product Manager.

Firms that recruited include Accenture, Adani, Airtel, Amazon, Apptus, Capgemini, Dr. Reddy's Laboratories, Genpact, HCCB, IBM, ICICI Bank, KEC International, McKinsey Digital, Mu Sigma, Persistent Systems, SAP, Telangana Government and Virtusa Polaris. Accenture and Persistent Systems have made the largest number of offers. There were no international offers made this year.

## Description of Salary Heads

- a) Fixed Yearly Cash Component: This is a total of the annual basic salary and additional guaranteed cash components. These additional components include cash payments and allowances that are part of the annual package. The term guaranteed signifies that the amount is certain unless there is an overall pay revision. The components falling under this salary head are final and are not related to performance.
- b) One-time cash Payment: This head indicates the value of the remuneration given to a candidate as one-time cash benefit mostly at the time of joining.
- c) Total guaranteed Cash Component: This is the sum of fixed yearly cash component and one-time cash payment.
- d) Maximum Earning Potential: This is the sum of total guaranteed cash component, maximum possible-linked variable pay and all other components of salary that are a part of the offer. This can include long term compensation such as PF, gratuity and other perks as well.
