It is responsible for the Ground Segment of Remote Sensing Programme through satellite data acquisition, archival, processing, dissemination, Remote Sensing Applications, Training and Capacity Building. It provides of Aerial services in the civilian Sector for the country. The Organization has five Regional Centres at Bangalore, Nagpur, Kolkata and Jodhpur to address region/area specific remote sensing application needs. The Earth Station located at Shadnagar, 65 kms from Hyderabad city, which is being developed as a full fledged centre to carry out the entire chain of remote sensing activities. NRSC is continuously exploring the practical use of Remote Sensing for societal applications through multilevel initiatives, development of value added data services and Remote Sensing Applications.

The pre-eligibility qualifications of ME/M.Tech/MSc.(Engg) or its equivalent should be in First Class with an aggregate minimum of 60% or CGPA/CPI grading of 6.5 on a 10 scale and M.Sc./BE/B.Tech/B.Sc.(Engg) or equivalent should also be in First Class with an aggregate of 65% (Average of all semesters or CGPA/CPI grading of 6.5 on a 10 scale or equivalent). Rounding-off marks is not allowed.

Age Limit: No age limit.

Reservations:

For PWD persons, orders on reservation to the extent applicable will be extended for the above post.

Pay & Allowances:

Selected candidate will be appointed as Scientist/Engineer 'SD' in the pay band of Rs.15600-39100/- with grade pay of Rs.6600/-. The gross emoluments in the minimum of pay band will at present be approximately Rs.41,830/-.

In addition HRA and Transport Allowance at the prescribed rates in force at the place of posting will be paid for those who are not provided Departmental Housing and Transport Facility. The employees will be governed by New Pension Scheme. ISRO provides attractive benefits to its employees such as medical facilities for self and dependants, subsidized canteen facilities; free transport (in lieu of transport allowance), limited housing facility for fresh entrants (in lieu of HRA), Leave Travel Concession; Group Insurance, advances for purchase of conveyance, construction of house etc.

Selection Process:

The qualifications prescribed in this advertisement are the minimum requirement and the same does not automatically make candidates eligible to be called for interview. Based on the details of marks furnished by the applicants, the candidates will be shortlisted for interview. Marks obtained in the minimum qualification required and also the performance of the candidates in the lower qualifications i.e. B.Sc./M.Sc./B.E/ B.Tech/ME/M.Tech etc. shall be taken into account for short listing the candidates. Candidates called and attended for interview shall be reimbursed to and fro second-class train fare by the shortest route from the address given in the application to the place of interview.

How to apply:

- The application for on-line registration will be hosted in the NRSC web-site between <u>05.10.2012</u> and <u>25.10.2012</u>. Candidates may visit our web-site at <u>www.nrsc.gov.in</u> to register their applications on-line between <u>05.10.2012</u> and <u>25.10.2012</u>. **Applications will be received on-line only**. Upon registration, applicants will be provided with an on-line Registration Number, which should be carefully preserved for future reference. E-mail ID of the applicant will have to be given in the application compulsorily.
- After the on-line registration, the final degree/marks certificate of Ph.D./ME/M.Tech/M.Sc./BE/B.Tech as the case may be duly indicating the registration No, Post No. and Advertisement No. on the reverse of the degree/marks sheet may be sent to the Administrative Officer (R&R), NRSC, Balanagar, Hyderabad-500037 within 7 working days after the last date. Please note that the on-line registrations, in respect of which final degree/marks are received within the stipulated time shall only be considered.
- The on-line application has to be invariably followed-up with a "No Objection Certificate" from the employer concerned, by those already in employment under Central/State Government, Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous Bodies, duly indicating the name and Reg. No. on the reverse of the NOC and the same may be sent to the Administrative Officer(R&R), NRSC, Balanagar, Hyderabad-500037 within 7 working days after the last date.

General Conditions:

- The Number of posts notified is provisional and may vary depending upon actual requirement.
- NRSC/ISRO reserves the right to fill or not to fill the post, if it so decides.
- The post is temporary but likely to continue.
- Candidates called for interview will have to produce all relevant original documents in proof of details furnished in their web application alongwith a set of attested xerox copies at the time of interview. In case any information furnished in the application is found to be wrong or false, the candidate will not be interviewed and TA will not be paid.

- The selected candidates are likely be posted in NRSC, Hyderabad (or) NRSC Earth Station, Shadnagar, Mahaboobnagar Dist., AP. However the Department reserves the right to post the candidate in any of the Centres/Units of the Indian Space Research Organisation/Department of Space situated anywhere in India as and when required.
