Ordinances

O. Sanskrit. Certi.01 - OBJECTIVE

O. Sanskrit. Certi.02 - SCOPE

All are interested in learning Sanskrit Standard 10th Pass will be Register to Course. No age Limit for the Course.

O. BAC. Certi. 02 (A) SCOPE

The intake shall be limited to '40' seats. The reservation policy for the time being in force shall be applicable. There shall be no upper Age Limit for filling Application.

O. BAC. Certi. 03- COURSES

- (1) The Course duration is of one term (i.e. Six months). the medium of the Instruction and Examination shall be the Sanskrit.
- (2) Eighty (80) percentage Attendance is Compulsory for Completion of Course.
- (3) Tuition fees shall be Rupees '250' for Female and Rupees '450' for male candidate

Candidate irrespective Standard-10th Pass shall be eligible for admission in the course

O. Sanskrit. Certi.06

The course is of six month duration and candidate shall have to complete the course within one year from the date of admission.

The syllabus for entire course is "BHASHA PARVESH"

O. Sanskrit. Certi.08

The Candidate well be required remain present department for at least 48 hrs. and shall have to carry out all the instructions of the course coordinator all concerned teacher

The prevailing reserving policy will be applicable as per rules of the state government of Gujarat.

Regulation

R. Sanskrit. Certi.01

The candidate should forward his/her application for admission in university examination through the Coordinator of the centre along with examination fee Rs. 50 and it should be submitted in the form prescribed by the University duly signed by the Coordinator of the centre.

R. Sanskrit. Certi.02

To pass the examination should obtain Minimum Passing mark in internal is 12 and external is 28 and aggregate 40%

R. Sanskrit. Certi.03

On Successful passing: the controller of examination will issue a passing certificate candidate.

R. Sanskrit. Certi.04

The Examination fees will be determined by the syndicate of the university.

R. Sanskrit. Certi.05

Candidate will be evaluated through examinations conducted by the teachers in the concerned "Centre for Promotion of Sanskrit, Indian Ethics and Values" immediately on finishing of course,

R. BAC. Certi. 06

The duration of the each course will be 72 hours to be completed in the six month. Minimum Course to be Completed (Maximum 2 Years).

The Panel of the Paper setter and Examiner will be prepared by the Teacher Imparting Instruction in the Centre Coordinator.
